Western Sydney Local Health District (WSLHD) and the Caring at End-of-Life team at Western Sydney University (WSU) are inviting you to a public forum to discuss the findings of this research project, with a great opportunity for your input.

Led by Dr Sally Greenaway (Director of Supportive and Palliative Medicine) the research has looked at the different end-of-life palliative care and bereavement needs of the Aboriginal community and those from Arabic, Hindi and Mandarin speaking backgrounds living in Western Sydney.
