Who can submit artwork?

Individuals or groups aged 16–24

When and where do I submit my artwork?

Please deliver your artwork to the AYAH (150 Darley Rd, Manly) on the 22nd or 23rd of May 2023 between 9–11am or 3–5pm.

What form of artwork can I submit?

Artwork can be submitted in the form of painting, drawing, photography, sculpture or poetry reflecting the theme of 'Comfort and Loss.'

Are there size or material specifications for artworks?

Artworks submitted on paper sized A2, A3, A4 or A5 will be hung from our artwork display units. If you intend to submit a larger canvas or sculpture, please provide notice so we can arrange the appropriate display equipment.
